PROJECTS APPROVED FOR UNWG FUNDING 2010

(Total: €205,336; 35 projects in 31 countries)

Africa (9 projects in 7 countries - €5,157)

<u>Congo</u>: Brazzaville - Comite de Construction de l'hopital de Maternite de Lande La Kayes: Construction of Maternity Hospital. This project supports the construct of a maternity hospital for women do not have access to medical care when giving birth. The community around the hospital provides the labor. Funds will be used for construction materials and 16-20 hospital beds. Cost €7,000

Ethiopia: 630 children; Goshebdo Elementary School; **Renovation for Goshebdo Elementary School.** Purchase of 210 desks (at present the children are sitting on stones and logs). Cost €7,000

<u>Kenya</u>: 754 children; Friends of Waluka (Vienna Based organization); **Water Harvesting & Construction of Masonry Tanks.** Purchase 2 water tanks for the primary school. Currently the students must walk down a hill to fetch water from a polluted stream. Cost €3,500

<u>Kenya</u>: 45 children or more at any one time; Agenda Africa. **Santa Maria Orphanage Rescue Center Help.** The Santa Maria Orphanage is in Kiambiu Slums. The rescue centre takes neglected children and orphans from the dump sites, provides a safe environment and tries to reunite the children with their families. The centre needs 40 mosquito nets, 40 mattresses, 10 beds, 80 blankets and 2 water tanks. Cost €2,728

<u>Kenya</u>: 160 children; St. Theresa's Special School for Mentally Challenged Children: **A Sick Bay.** This project will build a sick bay for mentally challenged children and provide a safe place for children when they are sick or have seizures. The nearest hospital is 5 km away and hard to get to without transportation. Cost €7,000

<u>Nigeria</u>: 400 children; Torch Bearer's Society: **Sinking of Bore Hole**. In the village of Akpoga in Nsukka District, there is no access to clean water. Currently the village uses water from a stream that is severely polluted. The bore hole will be in the school grounds but will be accessible by the whole community. Cost €7,000

Tanzania: 1,990 children; FOSOESE Foundation for Social Economic Services: **Preventing Childhood Malaria Death in Rural Areas**. This project will provide 1,990 treated mosquito nets to prevent childhood malaria in the rural Kibondo District. The target population is 5 years old or younger. Cost €7,000

<u>Uganda</u>: 200 children; Uganda Society of Hidden Talents; **HITS Primary School Solar Electrification Project:** This project is to fund will install solar electrification of the Uganda HITS (Hidden Talents) Primary school, a special school for disabled children. At present the children have only kerosene lamps and candles. The funds will also provide books and mathematics sets for the children. Cost €6,970

Zambia: 198 children; Cinici Wababili Rural Development: **Borehole Drilling & Construction**. The project is in Kasama Dstrict in the Northern Province. Funds will be used to complete and install a borehole and pump for a rural community. Cost €6,959

Asia & Pacific (7 project in 5 countries - €37,240)

<u>India</u>: 800 children; Education, Communication and Development Trust (EDUCATR): **Provision of Water Purification System:** The water purification system will be constructed at the Vellaimalaipatti Government School. At present these very poor children do not have access to clean drinking water. Cost: €1,905

<u>India</u>: 410 children; Peoples Association for Rural Women's Organization: **Vocational Training**Centre_This centre will service Dalit, disabled and drop out children in the Madurai District. This rural area is perennially drought prone and under developed. To break the cycle of poverty and deprivation new skills and trades will be introduced. The funding will purchase sewing machines, computers, and bookbinding equipment. Cost €4,500

<u>India</u>: 1581children; VOC Rural Development Centre; **Provision of Borehole and Toilet**Facilities in Two Schools for Children of Dalit Bonded workers. An Elementary School in

Poonchampatti Village and Panchayat High School in Vadipatti Village are located in a very poor
sector of the Indian community. At present these two schools do not have any toilet facilities or
water. Funds will be used for water borehole and toilet facilities. Cost: €2,835

Mongolia: 40 children; "Gerelt Mur" Center: After School Centre for the Children of the Informal Settlement of Ulan Bator: Due to drought and loss of livelihood nomadic tribes migrated to the city and settled in a slum area. There are insufficient classrooms and children attend school in shifts. The After School Centre will provide ongoing care and education of the children. Funds will be used for building materials of a prototype building that requires minimum cost. The community will be encouraged to use similar patterns to build homes. Cost: €7,000

Myanmar: 15,000 children; Nargis Library: **Rebuilding Nargis Library Destroyed by**Cyclone Nargis in 2008: Cyclone Nargis devastated this very poor area. This funding will build a library in Luputta Township to replace those destroyed in the cyclone. The library will be a centre for the community and used by visiting medical teams for needy patients. Cost: €7,000

Pakistan: 342 women, 342 children; Koohi Goth Hospital: Healing the Way Back to Life. This 40-bed hospital is situated in Deh Landhi, a suburban area of Karachi and provides services to 2 million people. Funds will be used to perform 342 VVF (vesico-vaginal fistula repair) & RVF (rectalvaginal fistula) operations on women who cannot afford the operation and are from less privileged backgrounds. Cost €7,000

<u>Sri Lanka</u>: 300 children; Priyad har shanarama Dhamma; **Priyad har Shanarama Dhamma** School Second Stage of Building of School: English Medium Dhamma School offers education to the less privileged children of this area. UNWG funded the first stage of building this school in 2008. The current funding will provide building materials for the second and final stage of the construction. The community will provide the labour as in the first stage. Cost: €7,000

Co-Action (1 project in 1 country - €4,258)

Mongolia: 85 children; IAEA PACT Division and National Cancer Center: Playground for Children. National Cancer Center in Ulambaatar is where children from all over Mongolia, particularly countryside, come for treatment and spend long time at the Hospital. Funds will be used to prepare the ground, gardening and purchase of playground equipment. Cost: €4,258

Austria & Austria-based (2 projects in 3 countries - €1,776)

<u>Austria</u>: 20 children/year; **Home for Mother-Child Haus Sarepta**. This facility is in Vienna and houses a Mother-Child Program that provides shelter to jobless, homeless and migrants families up to two years. The monies will buy equipment for a playground for the children. Cost: €4,776

Austria/Russia/Ukraine: 140 children; Kleine Herzen; Small carpentry Charity Center for Street Children in Quo Vadis, Ukraine and Vorontsovo Orphanage, Russia. In Ukraine the Center provides carpentry training to adolescents so they may earn their own living in the future. Funds will provide electric, heating, furniture and equipment for carpentry. In Russia new equipment will be purchased for teaching carpentry to boys before they leave the orphanage. Cost: €7,000

Europe (4 Projects in 4 countries - €25,260)

<u>Armenia</u>: 119 children; Gyumri Children's Home: **Reconstruction of Gyumri Childen's Home.** The orphanage needs urgent repair to provide basic sanitary and hygienic service to the children living there. Monies will pay reconstruction of walls, bathroom and kitchen. Cost: €7,000

<u>Belarus</u>: 200 children; Healthcare Institution "Minsk City Center for the Rehabilitation of Children with Psychoneurological Illnesses": **Strengthening the Capabilities of a Healthcare Institution**. The Minsk Center needs to acquire special equipment for the patients to stimulate the outflow of lymphs, relax musles and to purchase equipment for cerebral palsy clients. Monies will buy 2 machines HIVAMAT 200. Cost: €5,000

<u>Kazakhstan</u>: 78 children; <u>Electric Appliances for a Boarding School</u>. State Boarding School No.4 for speech and hearing impaired children is located in Cemey, in the Eastern Region of the country. Funds will be used to buy an Electric Stove for the school kitchen and equipment for the laundry room. Cost: €6,460

<u>Ukraine</u>: 90 children; Communal Institution Dobrodiya, Kalush East Ukrania: **Installation of a Heating System in the Orphanage**. Installment of an independent heating system for the Center for Children with special needs. This is an organization dedicated to children with severe disabilities such as cerebral palsy and Down's syndrome. Funds will be used for installation of independent heating system including pipes for wooden floors, batteries, boiler, etc. Cost: €6,800

Latin America (7 projects in 6 countries - €37,825)

Bolivia: 1,500 children; Para Ninos Pater Klau; Health Center Centro De Salud: The village of Cochamba needs a health facility for the majority of the population making a living on waste (rubbish). UNWG provides partial funding for the construct of a health center and medical equipment for vaccinations and dental treatment. Shortfall in funding will be paid by community friends and residents. Cost: €7,000

<u>Colombia</u>: 305 children; Semilla De Vida Eterna seVe; **Equipment of the diningroom of the Communitarian Center in the social affected area in Bella Flor:** The Bella Flor community centre in Simon Boliver, Central Columbia helps victims of extreme poverty, violence and starvation. Funds will be used to refurbish the dining room (refrigerator, stove etc.) Cost: €7,000

Colombia: 162 children; Fundacion Eduardo Echeverry Abella: Biblioludoteca Corregimiento La Olga Municipio De Yumbo Departmento Del Valle Del Cauca. Buy books for a library in La Olga Municipio De Yumbo. Cost: €7,000.

El Salvador: 307 children; Center Escalar Catolico Parroquial (Catholic Parish School): Estudiantes Saludables - Healthy Students: Funds will be used to detect dengue fever, parasites, repertory problems, diarrhea and anemia as well as purchase of medicines for children in need. Cost: €2,650

<u>Mexico</u>: 200 children per year; Ninos y Adolescentes en Amonia AC: Combatiendo el Rezago Educativo en La Zona Metropolitana de Guadalajara. Jalisco State has is an area with demonstrated need for education improvment. Funds will be used for basic school equipment for children and a copier for the school. Cost €2,000

<u>Nicaragua</u>: 145 children; Fundacion Social Nuestra Senora Del Perpetuo Socorro: **Refurbishing** of school building- Reacondicionamiento de La Escuela San Francisco de Asis Del Barrio Monte Tabor, Managua, Nicaragua The money will be spent for roof, floor, painting and other building materials. Cost: €5,175

<u>Paraguay</u>: 50-100 children; Fundacion Madre Paraguaya; **Ampliacion Guarderia De Ninos** - **Extension of Nursery Facility**: This facility is for children in a small village. Funds will be used for brick, roof, plastering, wood etc. Once the extension is completed the building may also be used for other community programs. Cost €7,000

Middle East& Northern Africa (5 projects in 5 countries - €33,820)

<u>Jordan</u>: 100 children; Holy Land Institute for the Deaf; **Hearing test Equipment for children in low income rural communities**: The institute will test children in poor regions for hearing loss. Children who are identified as having a problem will be assessed for hearing aid assistance. Cost €7,000.

<u>Lebanon</u>: 100 Children/year; Mar Semaan Centre; **Electric Installation:** A center for poor children in a remote area on the mountain needs to change the old and dangerous electric wires for heating and hot water, as well as for the safety of the center and children. Money will be used to buy wires, sockets and related materials. Cost €7,000

<u>Morocco</u>: 250 Children; Financement de L'Operation De Creusement De Puits, **Bore Hole**Construction: The organization will drill a bore hole to provide clear drink water for children in the remote desolate area in southern part of Morocco. Cost €7,000

<u>Palestine</u>: 50 Children; Right to Live Society; <u>Preparation of 2 occupational therapy rooms to improve the skills of individuals with autism</u>. Located in Gaza strip, the organization needs equipments for the occupational therapy rooms to help children with autism so they may be independent in the future. Cost: €5,820

Syria: 85 Children; Armenian Relief Society; School uniforms and winter clothing. The project is in Bab-Touma Sefel Al Talleh opposite Syrian Orthodox Church in Demascus. The organization needs winter clothes and school uniform for poor orphan children. Without a uniform they cannot attend school. Cost €7,000
